


E. SESSION SUMMARY:

The target is in an area of relative uniformity e.g. ground cover, beige coloration, terrain, etc. There are at least two objects present. One, the larger, feels like a structure which is either partially buried or has had soil/earth placed on top of it. Nearby is a smaller object/structure; it is similar in shape but feels as if it is mobile. The top, central panel of the latter object separates and flips open. This movement allows something else to either rise up or be released upwards.


There are chunks of brown and gray rock scattered about the area. There is movement across the ground and a burning sensation in my nose. There are two spirally motions which move towards each other to a central point. Sometimes they touch, other times they come close but don't actual meet.

----The target is comprised of two slow moving objects located in a closed circular area.

----Liquid (water) is present. There is the presence of brown tubular objects and the discernible activity of fast motion.

----Vehicles are or could be there.
