2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Viewer tasked in accordance with mission tasking reflected in Para 1, above.
3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: Viewing premises was very warm to the point of distraction. Viewing in a predictive mode is the most difficult task a viewer can attempt. Viewer 018 has had intermittent successes in such endeavors.

BACKGROUND: The issue of specific interest centers around possible acts of terrorism that could be directly or indirectly initiated by Iran in retaliation for the recent downing of the Iranian Jet Air Bus by the USS Vincennes in the Persian Gulf.

ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION: For the period of 31 July 1988 through 8 August 1988:

--- Determine if any acts of terrorism are to be initiated directly or indirectly, against the US in retaliation for the downing of the Iranian Jet Air Bus.

--- Describe the nature of the activity, if any.

--- Describe the projected results of the activity.

--- The reporting of an absence of a projected activity is acceptable and useful when it is so perceived.

1. (S-SS) Statistics: Viewer: 018
Session date: 29 JUL 88

2. (S-SS) Cuing: Determine if any acts of terrorism will occur between 31 Jul 88 and 8 AUG 88, in reaction to the Iranian Jet Air Bus downing in the Persian Gulf.

3. (S-SS) Tasking: Determine:

- a. Will/will not there be any event?
- b. If so, what will it be?
- c. If so, describe the projected results.

4. (S-SS) Comments:

a. The session started with a Stage 6 time line, marked with the individual days. The entire timeline was not probed for "peak feelings", but acted only as a cueing for tasking myself with the problem on a day-to-day basis.

b. Perceptions were coming quickly and strongly throughout the session, until page 16, when I suddenly realized that the perceptions for the string of days "fit together" almost too well, and I began to fear ADL drive. I stopped the session at that point.

c. The overall gist of the entire session (if it is not all ADL drive) would appear that an American sailor on R&R in a city near the Persian Gulf is taken hostage in an out-of-the-way place he frequents, after his ship has returned to port after being in some sort of sea battle.

5. (S-SS) Results: Perceptions received by probing the signal line on a day-to-day basis were as follows:

a. 31JUL88: Structure on water is passed by (ADL: a rocket). It is a minor incident, and doesn't really disturb anyone or anything.

b. 01AUG88: Rough feeling causing sick feeling in stomach, and bumping feeling. This was followed by a passage from roughness into smooth calm. There is a perception of rough land "nearby". (ADL: ship entering a harbor from the high seas.)

c. 02AUG88: Feeling of land. Impression of a male person running down a massive stone area in an enclosed area of a city. He feels a mischievous sense of pleasure at knowing of a "secret place", and not telling anyone else about it. There is a definite "back alley" feeling to the place. In the same place, there was a feeling of at least two persons who were just observing (ADL: observing him).

d. 03AUG88: Quiet, peaceful feeling accompanied by an "R&R", "easy life" feeling.

e. 04AUG88: Perceptions of being on water, looking with longing and displeasure out at land. "Drudgery" feeling. There was the feeling of being pulled away from what I really wanted to do, against my will.

f. 05AUG88: Generally no outstanding feelings at all except quiet and calm.

g. 06AUG88: The impression that there was some kind of a battle. There was a very physical impression of being suddenly thrown to one side as the floor "lurched" in one direction, accompanied by a loud sound. This was followed by a return to smooth water with large waves.

h. 07AUG88: Again there was the same impression of being on land. There was a vague visual of a city on very uneven land with narrow streets and some tall buildings. The person viewed earlier (c., above) was back again, ending with an impression that there was a quarrel of some kind. This was followed by the impressions that the person was riding in a very rough-riding vehicle which was going up into very rough high country. There was an accompanying feeling that he was riding in a very strange position, and his hands were tied behind him. The ground outside the vehicle looked very yellowish.

j. 08AUG88: I found the same person quiet, "wondering". His hands were still tied.
