SUMMARY

At this time, Date Time Group 191030Z MAY 88, USMC LTC William Higgins is being held in a very small rowboat located at Grid Indicator "C-7", estimated as being located at about 9.5 statute miles west of a point slightly higher than the geographical location known as "Al Khidr". See Grid Reading "H-3". Higgins will be moved from this position within the next twenty-eight hours. His captors have been unsuccessful in bringing (delivering) LTC Higgins to Beirut. They reached the southern outskirts of Beirut in an area located in the vicinity of Ayat, Aynnub and Alayn (Grid Indicator H-3); while at these locations, the captors received assistance locally but were unable to proceed further. Their trek north towards Beirut was curtailed as a result of the infighting in southern Beirut by the rival Shiite factions, the Hezbollah and the Amal groups. LTC Higgins will be released when he is driven to the outskirts of Beirut in an area described as soft and grassy. Prior to his release, he will be allowed (forced) to see the other US hostages. Notification of his release by the captors will be telephonic. Subsequent to his release from captivity, LTC Higgins will be transported home by ship. LTC Higgins is acutely aware of the fact that he is being held in a very small craft (boat).
