RESPONSE: Current location in an area between Cuba, Haiti, and Great Inagua Island (Windward Island) ^{to within 50.} approx 2030 N / 73 40 W

2. Describe the type of contraband aboard ship, if any. Determine how wrapped, and where stored.

RESPONSE: Contraband is in oblong "blocks" in a dark brown or grey paper wrapping. Substance is dark, crumbly, fragrant, almost a smell of loam. Stored approximately center forward of ship, above deckline in superstructure or deck cargo. Impression of container ship + containers.
