SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The vessel described in the last session is [REDACTED].
Vessel A is long, flat, and wide. The hull is black, the
superstructure (which is located in the stern) is black and white
with a red extension on top (like a chimney). There are numerous
huge (room-size) metal and wooden crates on the deck in front of
the superstructure (see sketch page 1).

The location of the transfer between ships A and B is marked
[REDACTED]. The transfer took place on 21 MAR 1990 between 0501-
0600 hours local time.


The location where vessel A will unload its cargo of
