(U) I have reviewed your June 1982 and May 1983 memos with the INSCOM Staff Psychologist who is my principal advisor on this project. Based upon this initial review, I would welcome an official proposal.

(U) Information not reflected in your memo which needs to be addressed in your proposal include:

a. (S/CL-1/NOFORN) Phase 1: Who are "calibrated" remote viewers? How many are we talking about? What is an "extended Wechsler" test? Where will the testing take place? How long will the testing take? Who will perform the data analysis?

b. (U) Phase 2: Why were the Wechsler, Meyers-Briggs and 16 PF chosen as the instruments? What is the outcome expectation? Where will the "second group of individuals" be drawn from?

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c. (U) How long to completion of the project? How long will each phase last? What percentage of contract funding will be assigned to each phase?

(U) Another question is the apparent lack of relationship of the screening approach described in the memo of June 1982 and your new approach as stated in the memo of May 1983?

(U) To allow sufficient time for a review of your proposal and to meet administrative requirements for funding in FY 83, an expeditious response is requested.
