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INTRODUCTION

This report is written to present the status of work being accomplished in Project "Sigm" to summarize the data collected on sightings of unidentified aerial objects, to review the methods and reasoning applied in the evaluation of the data, and to present the results so far obtained from the study of data available.

It is not expected that this report can present a final estimate of the situation regarding all the incidents reported. The data is still being studied by specialists in the fields of astronomy and psychology, and further information is being collected to enable personnel evaluating project "Sigm" incidents to determine possible explanations of some of the sightings. However, the report will furnish information on the present state of the investigation to staff personnel in this headquarters and in other echelons, and to others who are required to assess the possibility of a threat to national security presented by the sighting of such large numbers of unidentified flying objects.

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
