

During the period 1 January to 30 June 1960, no reports of unidentified aerial phenomena gave any indication of a threat to the security of the United States, nor were there indications that these phenomena were other than entirely

This category includes U sightings (UIC) reported by individuals who in each case there were no supporting witness and no additional information or facts available to allow a valid scientific evaluation of the sighting. Sightings of this nature must be discarded because of a total lack of supporting data. Data in effect reduces the total number of cases for the period to only 171, with 122 of these evaluated to date. In the case of the other 49 sightings in the unidentified data category, additional witnesses contacted with sightings but did not provide sufficient data to allow a valid description. Percentages are straight mathematical computations derived out of only two places based upon totals and sub totals of percentages. Therefore when rounded to percent they will not reflect the exact obtained total or sub total.

UIC cases or files are not placed nor should additional information be obtained as a later date, if was result in a revised case and/or may change the category previously assigned to the individual sighting (as in the case of a

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
