From the descriptions given by the various observers -- notably that the object was appeared like a slender, pointed object, was fleshy white, moved slowly and continuously, was a long vertical cylinder -- one can conclude that there is a strong possibility that the object was looking more than a short, vertical, opaque smoke trail. These trails are known to persist for half an hour or more, and to drift with prevailing wind aloft. The fact that one observer stated that at first the object appeared as white is excellent corroborative for the above explanation.

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
