Incident 2130 - visible, duration - 10 May 1964

If the report is to be correct, the value, then an astronomical explanation of this incident is possible.

However, in adding even a remote logical explanation for the incident, the present investigator is impressed with the fact that on this very night, May 17, there was an extremely brilliant, with a magnitude of +1.0, or about 100 times brighter than a first magnitude star. It would have appeared that night as an intensely bright light in the northwest.
