Incident #124, 11th St. Annex, Washington - 20 May 1944

There is no direct astronomical explanation for this incident.

This investigator draws his attention to the fact that the objects observed were seen at essentially the same level as the lower cloud stratum and that there was a high overcast. Could it be that these objects are successive strata of multiple, through breaks in the high overcast, illuminating small portions of the lower cloud stratum? Apparent speed of the objects could then have been a combination of the relative velocity of the G-47 and the projected motion of the breaks in the overcast.
