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Accident 4107, 4 -- Bureau, Date 1-4-52, 1949

The object sighted here was probably a bright, above  
medium meteor. It is described as a "bright yellow-white light,"  
moving at a "variable" rate of speed, and was in sight for one  
or three seconds.

This investigator is a bit struck by the reference to,  
the ubiquitous word, "bright meteoroid" was observed, at the  
stated hour of observation, the area had not yet risen.

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
