

Ex. 173: Weather balloon released from Lufkinville 120 at 1500 GMT. Description: A line of white of very light line of a small device which extended through the 500 ft. level. It all probably, weather balloon path was circular following: latter somewhere around airport. Some balloon was seen approximately 1000 ft. later in the same area. According to balloon line, not after other balloons, the weather balloon would have reached 1000 ft. to be seen. It was reported as high as 2000 meters for speed. Conclusion: Weather balloon.

Ex. 174: Weather pilot balloon subject: seen as was at Long Charles at 1500 GMT. Also the 175 at lower levels, due to 175 with altitude. The clouds at high speed relative to very pilot balloon subject from Long Charles to the 1000 ft. altitude were reported. Only other release in the area was at about 1000 ft. from Long Charles. Some about 1000 ft. speed stated by observer at 200 ft. alt. is approximately 15 times greater than any wind reported for that area. Conclusion: Not a balloon.

Ex. 175: Pilot balloon according released by a balloonist at same time as observation. Upper clouds also this time would not have been the all balloons. Great differences in opinion exist as to speed and shape of the object. One observer stated that the object was not a weather balloon. All evidence indicates that this is true. Conclusion: Not a balloon.

Ex. 176: Long weather and weather balloon pilot balloon according were released approximately one hour prior to sighting. That time, however, was 176 at all levels from the surface to 15,000 feet pilot balloon seem to preclude the possibility of either balloon drifting north to the San Pablo area. Both witnesses also agree that the object was travelling at high speed. Aside for that reason and not observed by a. Conclusion: No balloon.
