

Incident No. 25 -- 29 June 1948, WAG, Des Moines, Iowa.
 The observer, a bus driver, reported observing unknown objects at 1200 ft altitude, traveling in a straight line in file at 300 MPH. The objects were ellipsoidal in form "inverted saucer", 12 ft wide, 175-200 ft in diameter, dirty white, and made a sound like an electric motor or dynamo. There was no further information supplied except that the observer stated they looked like dots in the sky.

ANV Comments: These objects were seen just outside Des Moines, and were flying toward Des Moines. If they were not ordinary objects mistaken for something else by the observer, but were really unusual aircraft, it would almost certain that someone else would have also reported them. There is insufficient information for a proper analysis.

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
