

Incident No. 50 -- On June 1963, LHO and LHO, Hayward, Calif. The observer, an experienced pilot, reported sighting the and later seven objects at 1500 ft altitude, traveling from left to right. The objects were apparently at a considerable distance, the observer described them as being similar to the 1954-1 "Flying Flapjack." He stated that he attached no particular importance to this sighting until he read of the Sanado Islands sighting (Document No. 17). He then recalled this incident.

ALL Comments There is no information contained in this report to refute the assumption that these objects were ordinary aircraft beyond the range of identification. The fact that no one else in Hayward reported observing anything unusual, tends to substantiate this conclusion.

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
