

Incident No. 6. - 19 August 1967, 2100 hours, Dog Point, 300m.
Several people were reported as sighting enormous groups of objects in the
night sky. These objects were described as a glow in the air with a color
similar to vaporizer electrical lights. The objects were said to have traveled
at "terrific" speed. Dogs flew in irregular formation. Three dogs were
seen off one group of ten, and proceeded in another course. The sky was over-
cast. Two observers stated that the objects would not have been birds since
the lights were not a reflection of city lights.

NOT CONTAINS: Many familiar objects visible because of the fact that
they reflect light, similar to the moon, for example, the moon and
certain planets. The evidence is, therefore, contradictory since it was
stated the objects are described as being a glow, and later on as not being
reflective. The admitted evidence is possibly explained as in Incident 62/
ground lights reflected from clouds, or lights in flight.

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
