

Incident No. 8 - 7 July 1967, 2300-0100 hours, Fairland, Fla.
One chairperson reported hearing a rotating noise and then seeing, five shiny objects gliding from 5000 ft to 2000 ft in fifteen to thirty seconds. He estimated the objects were one mile from him. The lead object was of plastic appearance and appeared to be towing the other four. The reporter made a sketch and submitted it as an exhibit. The sketch is roughly oval in diameter, closed top and bottom and with an opening in the rear on either side of a vertical line. Police records list the man as having been AWOL from the Navy on two occasions. A neighborhood and employment check disclosed he is an amiable person, very intelligent, possesses an exaggerated low opinion, and inclined to impress people with his sophisticated verbal abilities.

MC Opinion: This Incident has all the aspects of a psychopathological report.

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
