

Incident No. 122 -- 5 April 1964, Pakistan Air Force Base, New Delhi.

Three balloon observers saw an object very high in the sky, moving faster than any known aircraft and possessing a rounded rectangular form which disappeared suddenly. It was over less than thirty seconds and was apparently not missed, judging by the violent reactions. For all-around size they stated if the rule were the size of an orange the object would approximate the size of a globe.

THE Conclusion. No explanation. However, the above comparison of size is to be noted. A disc half an acre in size would shield the sun from the eye even if the disc appeared several times larger than it does. To reduce the proportion then, this object must have appeared as an infinitesimal point. From trained observers, this is certainly a major discrepancy.

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
