

Incident No. 275 -- 5 Dec. 1966, 0815 hours, Redfish Lake,
Air Force Base, California.
The base control tower operator saw for 20 seconds a bright white
light in the air. It came into view two miles away at 500 to 1000 ft.,
sliding slowly at 100 MPH; at 2100 ft it slowed for a few seconds to
200 MPH; at this time, it oscillated or bounced, rose vertically to
3000 ft and immediately afterwards slid quickly to 20,000 ft and was
lost to sight.

AMC Opinion: There is no logical explanation for this incident
that fits the available evidence.

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
