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1. The images on the negatives were caused by light striking unexposed film. (I.e., the negatives were not retaken).

The individual lights in the "formation" varied in intensity.

The intensity was greater than any surrounding stars as the stars did not register. (The photos were taken under GAWU conditions.)

4. The individual lights showed position in the "formation".

C. Reinterrogation of the Photopainter

The GEL was requested to reinterrogate the photopainter in another effort to determine the authenticity of the photographs. The details of this reinterrogation have not been received but a preliminary report stated that there were no indications that the photographs were not authentic.

D. Future Investigations

A trip to Lockheed, Texas, will be made during January. Arrangements are being made to have a subject under observation and a physicist accompany Project Officer Wyckoff. If the photographs are authentic, they are important in that:

1. They will give an accurate measurement of the angular width.
2. The light source, although it appeared to be of low intensity to the eye, was clearly visible.
3. The movement of the individual lights in the formation can be studied further.
4. Locality correlation tests can be made.

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
