Appendix V.TRUSS MOUNT, BALDWIN - 9 October 1951I. DISCUSSION OF THE INCIDENT

On 9 October 1951 at 1340 GCT, a GAA Chief Aircraft Communicator observed a silvery object pass directly overhead while he was at Baldwin Municipal Airport, five miles east of Terre Haute, Indiana. The object was judged to be approximately the same size as a W 50 pent case held at arm's length. The object passed overhead at a very high rate of speed going in a southeasterly direction, passing from directly overhead to the horizon in about 15 seconds. There was no sound or vapor trails. The shape and general form of the object could be seen as the object passed over the horizon and out of sight.
