Appendix VIPARIS, ILLINOIS - 9 October 1951I. DESCRIPTION OF THE UNIDENTIFIED

On 9 October 1951, at approximately 1345 GMT, a private pilot enroute from Greenacres, Indiana, to Paris, Illinois, sighted a silver object just east of Paris, Illinois, at 1,300 ft. altitude. The object appeared to be stationary in so much as it did not increase or diminish in size with the approach of the aircraft. The object then started to travel in a northeasterly direction south of the Inowert, Keilans, Atomic Energy Plant.

II. WEATHER

Clear, bright sun, no clouds or haze.

III. RESULTS OF INVESTIGATION

Further investigation revealed no significant facts. It was impossible to determine whether or not there were any jet aircraft in the area due to the lapse of time since the sighting.
