Notears are identified mainly by the observer's description as to size, shape, and maneuvers. In some cases, exceptionally large notears or fireballs are plotted by observations and these plots are obtained.

F. Other

This category contains reports that have been proven to be known objects or phenomena, or the descriptions of the reported objects are similar to reports of known objects that do not fall into the above categories. Examples of these are birds, spurious radar phenomena, haze, etc.
