I. Description of Incident

Civilian source reported observing a bright, circular object, stationary in the sky east of Muburn, Alabama, at 1645 CST on 7 November 1952.

Weather at the time of the sighting was scattered clouds at 12,000', broken clouds at 25,000'. Visibility 4 miles due to smoke.

Source stated object looked like a star.

II. Discussion of Incident

It is possible that the object observed was a star. At 1645 CST it is dark enough to see the brighter stars. Sunset was at 1645 CST.

III. Conclusions

Probably a star.
