I. Description of Incident

Civilian sources reported that they used 8-power binoculars to observe two lights that appeared to be east of Washington National Airport. The lights were observed at 2150 EST on 10 November 1958 for a period of one hour. There was no apparent movement but they grew alternately brighter and dimmer. The lights were close enough together to be included in the field of view of the binoculars.

Weather reported to be 0-0 at Bolling AFB at 2200 EST but source stated there was no fog where he was.

II. Discussion of Incident

The data in the report is too sketchy for a complete evaluation, but it is possible two exceptionally bright stars were observed.

III. Conclusion

Possibly astronomical.
