that the radar personnel may have been looking at the planet Venus, very low and bright on the western horizon at this time of year, and that the radar possibly misinterpreted the aforementioned weather interference at the same time. This would require a high degree of coincidence, however, and the radar and visual sightings need to coincide too exactly to give much weight to the theory that both were observing different objects.

Two other items added to the completeness of the report. AFIC supplied the reporting intelligence officer with a USOP Technical Information Sheet, or a visual questionnaire, and an Meteorology Data Sheet covering the radar pick-up. Further analysis of this sighting and its atmospheric weather charts for the date and area of sighting and until data information is received, this report is carried in Project Blue Book's files as an unknown.
