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having difficulty. He took a realistic approach and had done some initial processing. He was worried about the fact that the light moved relative to the stars.

By eliminating doubtful sightings, the only thing that can be reasonably assured is that a OOC post observed a light. This could be a balloon or star. Radar picked up something in the general area of the OOC post and vectored an aircraft toward it. The pilot saw a light and wheeled in. He got a radar lock on it, but this could have been a malfunction. The star Capella is possibly visible low on the horizon to the north and the pilot would have seen this. Working further study, this incident is carried as Unresolved.
