serial drawings in the vicinity of Dallas, Texas, in winter 1961. The drawings appear to have been made recently as evidenced by the paper color of 11-17 August 1961, an unusual paper type located. However, on 14 March 1962, a large wall covered concrete structure, located southeast and north of Dallas, was visited. On 17 July a red glowing ball was reported by a merchant stationed at the house, described later as a house, in Dallas.
