SA B. J. Russell and Col Kirkland conferred with members of [redacted] on 26 December 1950 in regard to Project Gringo. The question of whether or not there was enough material available on unidentified aerial objects to warrant a detailed scientific study was discussed. It was decided that there was enough material available and [redacted] would submit a proposal to furnish consultants in the fields of astronomy, medical psychology, physics, etc. They will also attempt to make a statistical analysis of the reports in an attempt to obtain some pattern or trend.
