## AIR INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION REPORT

<p>1. Sighting of three objects with a glimmering color, but with no observed propulsion system, exhaust, or contrail is reported. Objects were flying toward the East (within 90°) and disappeared in that direction. Observation angle was approximately 60°. Sighted at 1045PM 1 June 1958, and visually observed for approximately ten minutes.</p> <p>2. Mr. Ray Lettman, of Ephrata, Washington observed the objects at Soap Lake, Washington. Observer claims he recently sighted similar objects in French Morocco. Mr. Lettman's telephone number is Ephrata 11794-4. Reliability of witness cannot be judged.</p> <p>3. Report was submitted to McChord Flight Service Center, McChord Air Force Base, by Seattle Air Route Traffic Control Center (Civil Aeronautics Administration), at 1056PM 1 June 1958. McChord Flight Service Center submitted FLEIGHT, via airtelized memo, in accordance with Air Force letter 200-5.</p> <p>4. Weather at time of sighting was reported as follows:</p> <p>a. Ephrata, Washington - thin scattered clouds at 25,000 feet, visibility 15 miles.</p> <p>b. Soap Lake, Washington - thin scattered clouds at 25,000 feet, visibility 30 miles, with cumulus clouds in all quadrants.</p> <p>5. One jet aircraft was reported in the general area at time of sighting.</p> <p>Comments Comments of the Preparing Officer:</p> <p>1. Lack of information, between the observer and Seattle Air Route Traffic Control Center was not reported, but was probably through the Interstate Airways Communications Station (Civil Aeronautics Administration) at Ephrata, Washington.</p> <p>2. The City of Soap Lake, Washington is 5 1/2 miles from Ephrata, Washington, on a true compass bearing of approximately 30°. Whether observer was actually in Soap Lake at the time of the sighting, or whether he was in Ephrata and noted that the objects were in the vicinity of Soap Lake, is indefinite.</p> <p>3. Witness was not contacted or interrogated. Additional information can probably be obtained by correspondence or interrogation.</p>
