SUMMARY: Report contains information reference sighting of unidentified flying object near Napa, Washington, 1 June 1958.					
Single object was sighted by USAF officers and airmen, and by civilian observers, and was observed for one hour. Interception was attempted. Weather at time of sighting was excellent for observation. Astronomical data indicates possibility that object was the planet Jupiter.					
Report is considered very reliable, and on-the-spot investigation was made by the observers.
