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STATEMENT OF SOURCE

At 2000 hours on 5 June 1952, the undersigned, his wife Barbara V. Roper and Valeria Wainwright, 1415 Pliny Street, Omaha, Nebraska, approached highway #78 from Alvin, Fort Omaha, Nebraska in the undersigned automobile.

The undersigned looked North to check for approaching cars before pulling onto the highway at which time he noticed a bright red light hovering at approximately 1,000 feet, 1/4 mile North, Southwest of Tola Station.

This light was very bright and hovered in one spot not varying right or left, nor up or down for approximately 1 to 1 1/2 minutes at which time the light started moving South at a very high rate of speed and disappeared in approximately 2 to 3 seconds.

The undersigned then drove to the SAC Main Gate and informed Lt. Colonel Arthur E. Schell, Staff Duty Officer and T/Sgt L. C. Stammen, Sgt of the Guard, of the incident by telephone.
