1. FAST MOVING OBJECTS SIGHTED FOLLOWED BY UNDULATING SLOW IN REAR,  
NO RECOGNIZABLE SHAPE OR SIZE DUE TO DARKNESS. APPROX TWENTY IN GRP  
FOLLOWING IDENTICAL TRAJECTORIES SOMEWHAT FLATTER THAN THAT OF HIGH  
SPEED SNELL. NO EXHAUST TRAIL, INDEFINITE STRETCHING IN REAR. SPEED TWO  
TO THREE THOUSAND MPH, NO SOUND. INITIAL NOTED TRAJECTORY FROM POINT  
HIGH AND TO RIGHT OF ACFT NOISE DROPPING FROM FIVE THOUSAND FEET WHEN  
FIRST NOTED TO FIVE HUNDRED FEET APPARENTLY FLATTENING TRAJECTORY AND  
MAINTAINING ALTITUDE UNTIL DISAPPEARING. APPARENT MASS PRECEDING LIGHT  
BECAUSE OBJECTS COULD ONLY BE SEEN OUTDOORS FROM OBSERVER. 2. TIME OF

TOTAL OBSERVATION TIME 3 MIN. 3. MANNER OF OBSERVATION, VISUAL FROM AIR,  
FLYING T-4 AT 3000 FT, HEADING EIGHTY DEGREES, TURNED TO 500 DEGREES  
AND PARALLELLED TRACK OF OBJECTS. 4. LOCATION LAT 45 DEGREE 16 MINUTES  
NORTH, LONG 52 DEGREE 10 MINUTES WEST FIVE MILES NW OF MPLS, MINNESOTA.  
WITH RESPECT TO OBSERVER OBJECTS WERE 3000 FEET CLOSING TO 1000 FEET
