SYNOPSIS  Investigation initiated by District Commander upon information that Doctor A. W. WARD had sighted a bright luminous object travelling across the sky. WARD interviewed, related object sighted approximately 0300 hours, 20 April 1952, from WARD's country home on Grizzly Island, Solano County, California. The object was travelling in a straight line from the northwest horizon to the southwest horizon, the altitude and speed of object were not estimated. WARD observed no aerodynamic features of the object and related object did not appear to be a meteor.  DOWNGRADED AT 3 YEAR INTERVALS; DECLASSIFIED AFTER 12 YEARS. DOD DIR 5200.10
