reveals that between the hours of 2100 and 2300 on 11 July a light was again observed at the same point. No other sightings had been made (reference of 2411 1299) (2411). During the same period two groups of 10 planes were reported in low visibility at the light. One aircraft was believed to have crossed between 2100 and 2300 hours over Friend's Lines. It is the opinion of the Armed Force personnel that this light is supposed to be a balloon and is being used as a check point for enemy planes. Another opinion is that the light may be a reference point for enemy ground troops on patrol.

COMMENTS ON SOURCE OF INFO

This light is possibly a balloon over the balloon station on July 11, 1962. June 29, 1962, and is used as a check point for enemy planes. It is also possible that it is a light over the Friend's Lines at night.
