0620Z numerous ground observers vicinity of Hill 183 at DF FWD reported sighting balloons shaped object appearing in air over Hill 190 at DF FWD. Object first appeared white and later changed to red in manner described by observers as if from intense burning. After 20 minutes object disappeared. As soon as first object disappeared, second one appeared approximately 6000 feet in the air above Hill 190. This object also turned from white to red and disappeared after about 20 minutes. Both objects hovered in the air and not as if suspended from a parachute. Sight was difficult to determine because distance from observers to object was unknown. No noise was seen. These objects were seen by numerous observers with the best observation on Hill 183.

a. Comment - These objects, apparently balloons with lights hung beneath them, have repeatedly been observed in this area. They are possibly used as signals for our night interceptors, or more probably as beacons or as a method of communication between enemy units.
