The following report of an unidentified flying object was given to the preparing officer by T/Sgt Harold D. Adams on 2 August 1962.

An unidentified flying object was observed on the radar screen at the Hayswood 300 site (31° 36' 30" N - 87° 1' 31" W) on 2 August 1962 at 1300 hours. The type of radar equipment used at the site is AN/SP-5 (modified) and was in operation 12 June 1962 between 1000 and 1400 hours. Aerial object observed was above 50,000 feet and the air speed was calibrated at 600 knots. The compass heading was 180°, then changed to approximately 210°. VFR conditions existed at the time of sighting, but no other sightings were reported. The only other aerial activity reported in this area was a C-119 aircraft flying towards the HWS site at 210 knots.
