Object appeared in the southeast at an elevation of approximately 10°. It traveled about 10° of arc downward at an angle of 45° with the horizon and toward the east. It was visible about 3 seconds.

The attached sketch shows its appearance to the best of my ability. The red dots indicate sparks which seemed to literally pour from the object to the rear as it slid. The object itself was circular or spherical and of a brilliant green or blue-green color, about 1/8 to 1/4 inch apparent diameter.

If the assumption is made that the object was moving away, the following properties are inferred:

1. $1/4$ inch, equals 1200 feet
2. Object appeared approximately $1/4$ inch dia. at a range length of 2 feet.
3. Obj. size equals 5280 feet.
