I, Russell E. Smith do affirm the following facts to be true to the best of my knowledge and observation:

Time: 0640 hours

Date: 18 June 1952

Place: Hampton Road and Castle Place, Dallas County, Dallas, Texas

Weather: No clouds over head - High clouds on horizon - No wind - Dark - Moon was low on horizon

Situation: I was walking East on Castle Place at the above mentioned time. I spotted the object over head, slightly to the right. It looked elliptical (I could have been round), white filmy color. The outer edge was reddish blue. It had concentric rings which were not connected to the central portion and elongated. It was extremely brilliant. It had its own source of light. Easily seen. I have never seen such color combinations before.

The object came from the West traveling East. It went by at a level altitude at a great distance before making a sweeping right turn (clockwise) and then immediately disappeared. There was no sound.

These measurements are approximate but I would say it was fifty to sixty feet in length and about thirty to forty feet in width. Its flight path was established by the large diameter of the object.

It appeared to fly faster than any normal type aircraft. The clockwise turn was exceptionally fast.

I have no idea of altitude.
