SUMMARY

On Saturday, 16 June, 1962, I was driving west on U.S. 66 about 15 miles west of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, again with my wife as a passenger, when we both observed a green colored fireball flash across the sky. The time was about 1 A.M. in the morning. The object appeared to the southwest of the highway, and flashed across the sky in a southeasterly direction. It lasted for only about three or four seconds, but it was extremely large in size, and was very noticeable. The color was extremely bright, and very definitely green. The sky was clear, with many stars, but the object was unlike any falling star that either myself or my wife had ever seen.
