SUMMARY None, this is an initial report			
SYNOPSIS Investigation initiated by Major General, 19th District, Travis AFB, in the last week of June 1952. ALBERTA E. HINDS , 2540 Alhambra Ave., Noroland, Calif., observed what appeared to be a round, brightly orange-colored object 4 to 6 inches in diameter, travelling at a high rate of speed in a southerly direction. Estimated time of sighting approximately 2100 hours. A similar object sighted by ALBERTA three or four nights later travelling in an identical course as the first object. Mrs. ALBERTA E. HINDS and Mrs. ELIZABETH BAKER , witnesses to the second occurrence, verified HINDS 's testimony as to description and speed of object. ALBERTA E. HINDS BAKER , another witness, stated the object appeared to consist of four or five small white lights in close formation, flying at a slower rate of speed than indicated by other witnesses. Mr. ALBERTA STRATTON who also witnessed the occurrence not available for interview.			
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
