Reported unknown tracking object from North to South, also Southwest. One report 10,000, the other 10,000 ft. Two sightings in the air. First, 10,000 ft, pilot Captain Glenn observed 170 knots, 9,000 feet below object. The second 7-33 AF Jet, 10,000, pilot Captain Williams, 10,000 feet below object. Five other reports on the ground. Four Washington, Va., two Rockswille, Va., and one Williamsville, Va.

Captain Glenn, Captain Williams, Ralph Watts, USA operator at Washington also estimated object 25-30,000 feet. Mr. Johnson, USA operator at Rockswille, Alan Wyatt, Williamsville, Va., (operator, Capt. Willie J. General Delaney), Franklin James, USA operator, Washington, (not on duty at the time he sighted the object), and Dr. William (William) at Washington.

Washington weather scattered light to moderate thunderstorms in area. 7,000 feet, 7,000 feet, 10,000 scattered 10 miles visibility 1000 FT. CMB.

Rockswille weather 7,000 scattered, 10 miles visibility. Wind about 10,000, 100 degrees, 10 knots, 10,000. Speed 100, 100, 1000 knots. This account for this sighting. Langley west a/c out 10,000.

The traffic was a traffic only over Washington, AF Jet was approximately 10,000 estimated about 10,000 feet above, drifting southwest.
