Dear Sir:

On Monday, June 23, between 7:50 and 8:15 P.M. I observed a flying object that I could not identify. It looked very much like an extremely bright star with an exaggerated tail. It appeared to me a very great distance away.

With the nearby surveyor's instruments I got the following readings from a point 3 miles southeast of Brownsville, Tex. Azimuth - 11° west of north-elevation on line; distance - 2 1/2 miles west of north-elevation 3°. Time of flight - 2 minutes - approximately.

I am positive that it was not an airplane and almost as sure it was not a weather balloon because I was on the wrong side to see reflection from the sun.

For any use this information on to whom is appropriate. I do not want any publicity so far as my name is concerned.
