SUBJECT: Sighting of Unidentified Object in Sky
Near Wright Air Development Center,
Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio
ORIGINAL INQUIRY

TO: Commanding Officer

Ohio

1. The following information is transmitted to your Headquarters for any action which may be deemed appropriate:

On 20 June 1962, Captain G. B. HUSSELL, 40-214000, Flight Safety Officer, Operations Building, Room 211, Phase 2-1204, Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, advised that he received a telephone call on 18 June 1962, from ELMER COGGAN, Civilian Employee, WACG (Wind Tunnel), Telephone 3-4130, to the effect that COGGAN had sighted an unidentified object in the sky near WACG on 17 June 1962, between 1600 and 1810 hours. A transcription of the telephone conversation between Captain HUSSELL and COGGAN was obtained from Captain HUSSELL and is attached hereto as Enclosure No. 1.

Captain HUSSELL further stated that EMMETT SYDORPAST, Civilian Employee, WACG (Wind Tunnel), Telephone 3-4109 and 3-4113, telephonically advised he had witnessed an unidentified object in the sky over WACG, Area 11P, 17 June 1962, between 1600 to 1810 hours and gave substantially the same information as COGGAN. Captain HUSSELL suggested that Colonel WALK, WACG, Telephone 3-0112, be contacted to determine if his section had any strange objects in the air 17 June 1962, that would resemble a flying saucer or that would tend to create an illusion.

2. No further investigation of instant matter is contemplated by this office, unless otherwise directed by your Headquarters.
