1. Object sighted was a light the same color as the stars but much brighter. It appeared in size as a planet compared to a star. No exhaust or trail could be observed. No maneuvers could be observed. Object faded from view into the milky way constellation.

2. Light was observed at 2:10 EDT and was observed for approx 30 seconds.

3. Observation was made visually from the air. I was in an F-96-B at 4,700 feet at an indicated air speed of 210.

4. Location was 81 degrees 35 N 70 degrees 30 E. I was flying a heading of 180 degrees. Object was sighted approx 25 degrees off port side of nose approx 30 degrees high. Object crossed port to starboard parallel with horizon and disappeared about 17 degrees to 15 degrees on starboard side until 30 degrees high. Distance unknown as no comparison in size could be made.

5. Pilot has approx 1700 flying hours and approx 9 years experience.

6. Weather was 2000 broken clear above visibility was excellent, winds light at time were 30 degrees 70 K.

7. Several squadrons were building up in vicinity of Providence RI and Boston Mass with occasional lightning flashes.
