SUBJECT: Sighting of Unidentified Object in Sky
Near Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio

1. The following information is transmitted to your Headquarters for any action which may be deemed appropriate:

On 28 June 1962, Mr. R. D. DILL, 2424 E. Nashville Road, Dayton, Ohio, Phone No. 236-0847, advised the Air Provest Laboratory Office, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, that he and his children observed what appeared to be a piloted aircraft.

Mr. DILL stated at 8:57 p.m., 17 June 1962, he and his children noticed large object approaching from the southeast headed northwest, then curved east. The object was very high and in his opinion was not a jet aircraft. Mr. DILL further stated the object was noticed for approximately ten (10) to twenty (20) seconds and he heard a faint buzzing sound.

2. No further investigation of instant matter is contemplated by this office, unless otherwise directed by your Headquarters.

3. Attention is invited to Paragraph 7, AFM 20-1, which it bears in mind, which prohibits the disclosure of classified information to unauthorized personnel.
