Upper Radar and Radar Visual Combined Detection

1. Gross Air Base, Lakeland - 19 June 1952

At 0400Z on 19 Jun 52 an object was sighted east of this base traveling from NE to SW. Member of observation visual from the ground. The object was described by the Air Force 2/11 who observed it as a red light, moving in a wobbly fashion, which turned white and disappeared.

CGA was contacted and reported a target on their scope in the same area where the visual observation was made. Object appeared stationary on the scope at no more than a 4000' height due to the limitations of the radar set. The blip would enlarge momentarily then return to its original size.

Solution: Possibly light reflection and radar return from snow clumps in the area.
