ALL OF JERSEY SHOOT, PA AND RAY WILLIAMS,
OPERATOR OF B AND C SERVICE STATION AT AVEE,
PA. THE OBJECT WAS FLYING AT APPROXIMATELY
5000FT, IS AND WAS DESCRIBED AS BEING SMALLER
THAN A DC-3 FOUND IN SHARP AND BRIGHT
SILVER IN COLOR. IT WAS HEADING IN A WEST
NORTHWEST DIRECTION. IT WAS OBSERVED FOR
APPROXIMATELY 15 MINUTES AND THEN DISAPPEARS
BEHIND THE MOUNTAINS. NO TRAIL OR EXHAUST
WAS OBSERVED. WEATHER AT TIME OF OBSERVATION
