7. Following the sighting, Captain Mathis immediately contacted meteorological observers at both Barksdale Air Force Base, and C.A.A. None of the personnel contacted admitted knowledge of meteorological phenomena or usage of equipment that might account for the incident. Base Weather Detachment at Barksdale Air Force Base reported launching a weather balloon at 2200 hours, above date. The balloon carried radio equipment, but no light.
