The weather conditions for the time of observation were as follows:

The weather was clear, visibility fifteen miles. Wind aloft 200° & 10 knots. No meteorological conditions affecting the report, nor air traffic in the vicinity of sighting to assume or contradict the existence of the sighted object.

EVIDENCE

There is no physical evidence to this report. Due to the fact that the observation was visual, based solely on the observation of one witness, lack of more definite identifying features of the object, this report is being submitted mainly for information and as a record of sighting.
